

Water-Saving Gardening Checklist for Kuwait

Perfect for balcony or rooftop gardens -- tailored to Kuwait's hot and dry climate. Last updated: August 15, 2025

	☐ Install a drip irrigation system
	☐ Use water timers to automate watering
	☐ Group plants by water needs
	☐ Use containers with drainage holes
	☐ Choose light-colored pots to reduce heat absorption
	☐ Secure lightweight containers against wind
*	Mulching & Soil
	☐ Apply 5-8 cm layer of organic mulch
	☐ Use coco husk, straw, or leaves as mulch
	☐ Avoid over-mulching near stems
	☐ Replace mulch every 3-4 months
	☐ Watch for salt buildup in containers
9	Shade & Temperature Control
	☐ Add 30-50% shade netting
	☐ Use removable nets for summer only
	☐ Monitor leaf temperature for stress signs
	☐ Remove shade nets during cooler months (Nov-Feb)
	☐ Inspect shade nets for damage after sandstorms

✓ Setup Essentials

 ☑ Drought-Tolerant Plants ☐ Plant rosemary, okra, amaranth, and lemongrass ☐ Use local varieties that thrive in heat ☐ Consider adding mint, basil, and desert sage ☐ Group heat-loving plants together
 Smart Watering Habits □ Water early morning (5-7 AM) □ Avoid overhead watering □ Check soil moisture before watering □ Adjust watering frequency by season (summer vs. winter) □ Reduce watering during cooler months
 Maintenance & Troubleshooting □ Clean drip irrigation filters monthly □ Check for clogged emitters weekly □ Adjust for Kuwait's occasional dust storms □ Monitor plants for heat stress during summer peaks □ Prune dead or damaged plant material regularly
Seasonal Adjustments
Summer (May-September) ☐ Increase shade coverage to 50% ☐ Water daily in extreme heat (45°C+) ☐ Move sensitive containers to shadier spots
Winter (December-February) ☐ Reduce watering to 2-3 times per week ☐ Remove or reduce shade nets ☐ Take advantage of natural rainfall
Spring/Fall (March-April, October-November) ☐ Gradually adjust watering schedules ☐ Best time for planting new varieties ☐ Prepare systems for seasonal changes
